Research carried out by the STARR Initiative revealed a need for skills training in the local area, over recent months we have worked with Shaw Trust to ensure the delivery of back to work training courses at The Phoenix Centre in Sandwich.

The aim of the course is to build confidence levels, teach IT skills and help you find a job that suits you, if you complete the course you will receive accreditation in Employability (ASDAN) EL3/Level 1 and during the training you find that your literacy and numeracy skills will be enhanced enough to gain a GCSE equivalent qualification.

If you are over 18 years of age, live in Dover or Thanet District areas, are in receipt of Income Support, Incapacity Benefit or Pension Credits and have less than 5 GCSE A-C passes then this course could be for you.

The courses run at The Phoenix Centre in Sandwich and are either full time, 5 days a week for 15 weeks or part time up to 16 hours per week for up to 30 weeks.
